

Sample Pattern-Crochet

Name of Design: Sample Sweater

Name of designer: Edie Eckman

Sizes: S (M, L, XL)

Finished Measurements

Chest at Underarm: 37 1/2 (41, 44, 44 1/2, 48)"

Finished Length: 22 (23, 24, 25)"

Materials

4 (5, 5, 6) skeins Cascade Yarns Cascade 220 (100% wool; 100g/220 yds) color 9495

Size I-9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook or size to obtain correct gauge

Stitch markers

Tapestry needle

Gauge

16 sts and 8 rows = 4"/10 cm in double crochet with size I-9 (5.5 mm) hook

To save time, take time to check gauge.

Special Stitches

Dc2tog – (Yarn over, insert hook into next st and pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through 2 loops) 2 times, yarn over and pull through all 3 loops on hook.

PULLOVER

BACK

Ch 80 (87, 94, 101). Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—78 (85, 92, 99) sts.

Next row (WS): Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), dc in each dc across. Work even 0 (0, 1, 2) more rows, turn.

Next row (dec row): Ch 3, dc2tog, work to last 3 sts, dc2tog, dc in last st—76 (83, 90, 97) sts. Continue to dec 1 st each side every other row 2 more times, then dec 1 st each side every row 3 times—66 (73, 80, 87) sts. Work even until piece measures 6 1/2 (6 1/2, 8 1/4, 7 3/4)" from beginning, turn.

Next row (inc row): Ch 3, dc in same st, dc to last st, 2 dc in last st—68 (75, 82, 89) sts.

Continue to inc 1 st each side every 4th row 3 more times—75 (83, 90, 97) sts.

Work even until piece measures 14 1/4 (14 3/4, 15 1/4, 16)" from beginning, turn.

Armhole shaping: Sl st in next 6 (7, 7, 8) sts, ch 3, dc to last 5 (6, 6, 7) sts, turn—65 (71, 78, 83) sts. Dec 1 st each side every other row 4 (6, 8, 9) times—55 (59, 62, 65) sts. Work even until armholes measure 6 3/4 (7 1/4, 7 3/4, 8)", ending with a WS row, turn.

Right shoulder and back neck shaping (RS): Sl st in next 8 (9, 9, 10) sts, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 9 (10, 11, 11) sts, turn. Sl st in next 4 sts, ch 3, dc across—7 (8, 9, 9) sts. Fasten off.

Left shoulder and back neck shaping (RS): With RS facing, skip 21 (21, 22, 23) sts, rejoin yarn in next st, dc to last 7 (8, 8, 9) sts, turn. Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 6 (7, 8, 8) sts—7 (8, 9, 9) sts. Fasten off.

FRONT

Make same as back until armholes measure 4 3/4 (5 1/4, 5 1/2, 5 1/2)", ending with a WS row.

Neck shaping

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3, dc in next 18 (20, 21, 22) sts, turn.

Row 2: Sl st in next 4 sts, ch 3, dc to end, turn—16 (18, 19, 20) sts.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc to last 2 sts, dc2tog—15 (17, 18, 19) sts.

Row 4: Ch 3, dc2tog, dc to end—14 (16, 17, 18) sts.

SLEEVES

Ch 33 (37, 38, 42). Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across—32 (35, 36, 40) sts.

Next row (WS): Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), dc in each st across.

Inc row (RS): Ch 3, dc in same st, dc to last st, 2 dc in last dc—34 (37, 38, 42) sts.

Continue to inc 1 st each side every 3rd row 8 (8, 3, 2) more times, then every other row 3 (3, 9, 11) times—56 (59, 64, 70) sts. Work even until piece measures 18" from beginning.

Cap shaping: Slip st in next 6 (7, 7, 8) sts, ch 3, dc to last 5 (6, 6, 7) sts, turn—46 (47, 52, 56) sts.

Next row: Sl st in next 3 sts, ch 3, dc to last 2 sts, turn—42 (43, 48, 52) sts.

Dec 1 st each side every row 4 (5, 6, 7) times—30 (29, 32, 34) sts. Fasten off.

Finishing

Block pieces to finished measurements. Sew shoulder and side seams.

Neck band: With RS facing, join yarn at right shoulder and sc evenly around neck edge; join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
