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#### NOTES

- 1) Charts for Patterns #1-7 are shown in two colors to distinguish the rows/rounds.
- 2) Charts for Patterns #8-10 are shown in three colors, indicating where colors A, B and C are used in each pattern.
- 3) Change to a new color on the last stitch of a row as directed, as follows: Work until 2 loops of the old color remain on the hook, yarn over with the new color and pull through 2 loops on hook to complete the stitch.
- 4) The yarn used for the photographed swatches is Lana Grossa Cool Wool (100% superwash merino, 1.75 oz [50 g]/175 yds [160 m], crocheted on a size H-8 [5 mm] hook.
- 5) This free stitch dictionary is intended to be viewed on a digital device and has not been optimized for printing. Reproduction and distribution without written consent is prohibited.

# Ten Stitches Dictionary

Use this sampling of stitch patterns in any way you choose, in any yarn and hook combination that suits you. Start with a 5-6" [13-15 cm] swatch so that you can practice the stitch and measure your gauge before beginning a project.


### Pattern #1

Ch 6, join with slip st to form a ring.


**Rnd 1:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), 15 dc in ring, join with slip st to top of beginning ch-3—16 dc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), dc in same st, ch 1, \*skip 1 dc, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next st, ch 1; rep from \* around, join with slip st to 3rd ch of ch-5, slip st in next space.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same space, \*ch 1, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 space; rep from \* around, join with sc to top of beginning ch-3.


**Pattern #2**

Chain a multiple of 2.

**Set-Up Row:** 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, skip 1 ch, \*2 sc in next ch, skip 1 ch; rep from \* to last ch, sc in last ch, turn.

**Row 1:** Ch 1 (does not counts as sc), 2 sc in first st, skip 1 sc, \*2 sc in next sc, skip 1 sc; rep from \* to last sc, sc in top of last sc.

Rep Row 1 for pattern.



**Pattern #4**

Chain a multiple of 6 + 3.

**Set-Up Row (RS):** Hdc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch counts as hdc), ch 3, skip 3 ch, hdc in next ch, \*ch 1, skip 1 ch, hdc in next ch, ch 3, skip 3 ch, hdc in next ch; rep from \* to last ch, hdc in last ch, turn.


**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in first st, \*ch 2, 3 dc in next space, ch 2, sc in next space; rep from \* across, placing last sc in top of turning ch, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 5 (counts as tr and ch 1), hdc in next dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc, hdc in next dc, \*ch 3, hdc in next dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc, hdc in next dc; rep from \* across, end ch 1, tr in last sc, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next ch-1 space, ch 2, sc in next space, ch 2, \*3 dc in next space, ch 2, sc in next space, ch 2; rep from \* across, end 2 dc in last space, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in next dc, ch 3, hdc in next dc, \*ch 1, skip 1 dc, hdc in next dc, ch 3, hdc in next dc; rep from \* across, end hdc in top of turning ch, turn.

Rep Rows 1-4 for pattern.



**Pattern #3**


Chain a multiple of 5 + 7.

**Set-Up Row (RS):** Dc in 12th ch from hook (skipped chs count as ch 4, dc, ch 4), \*ch 4, skip 4 ch, dc in next ch; rep from \* across, turn.

**Row 1:** Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), dc in next space, \*ch 4, dc in next space; rep from \* across, end ch 2, tr in top of turning ch, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 7 (counts as dc, ch-4), \*dc in next ch-4 space, ch 4; rep from \* across, end dc in top of turning ch, turn.

Rep Rows 1-2 for pattern.



**Pattern #5**

SPECIAL STITCHES

**Beg Y-st (Beginning Y-st):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc around post of ch-3 just made. Counts as 2 sts.


**Y-st (Y-stitch):** Dc in st indicated, dc around post of dc just made. Counts as 2 sts.

Chain a multiple of 2.

**Set-Up Row (RS):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn.

**Row 1:** Beg Y-st, skip 1 st, \*Y-st in next st, skip 1 sc; rep from \* to last st, dc in last st, turn.

Rep Row 1 for pattern.



**Pattern #6**

SPECIAL STITCHES

**Partial dc (partial double crochet):** Yarnover, insert hook into stitch or space indicated and pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through 2 loops.

**Shell:** (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in stitch or space indicated.


Chain a multiple of 9 + 1.

**Set-Up Row (RS):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, \*ch 1, skip 3 ch, shell in next ch, ch 1, skip 3 ch, sc in next 2 ch; rep from \* across, omitting last sc, turn.

**Row 1:** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in 2nd dc of first shell, \*ch 3, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-2 space, ch 3, skip 1 dc; partial dc in next dc\*\*, partial dc in 2nd dc of next shell, yarn over and pull through 2 loops on hook to complete dc2tog; rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, partial dc in last sc, yarn over and pull through 2 loops on hook to complete dc2tog, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 1, skip next space, shell in next space, ch 1, \*sc in next 2 ch-3 spaces, ch 1, shell in next space, ch 1; rep from \*, ending sc in top of last dc, turn.

Rep Rows 1-2 for pattern.



**Pattern #7**

SPECIAL STITCHES


**Shell:** (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in one stitch.

Chain a multiple of 8 + 4.

**Set-Up Row (RS):** Shell in 8th ch from hook (skipped chs count as ch 1, dc, 3 skipped chs), ch 1, skip 3 ch, dc in next ch, \*ch 1, skip 3 ch, shell in next ch, ch 1, skip 3 ch, dc in next ch; rep from \* across, turn.

**Row 1:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), \*shell in center of next shell, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1; rep from \* across, omitting last ch 1, turn.

Rep Row 1 for pattern.



**Pattern #8**

SPECIAL STITCHES

**Shell:** 5 dc in 1 st or space.

**X-st:** Dc in space between next sc and the following shell, ch 1, dc in space between sc just skipped and the preceding shell.

Using colors A, B and C.

With A, chain a multiple of 6 + 2.

**Set-Up Row (RS):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, \*skip 2 ch, shell in next ch, skip 2 ch, sc in next ch; rep from \* across, changing to B on last sc [see Note 3, page 1].


**Row 1:** With B, ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in same st, ch 1, sc in center dc of next shell, ch 1, \*X-st, ch 1, dc in center dc of next shell, ch 1; rep from \* across, end 2 dc in last sc, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 3, 2 dc in same st, sc in next sc, \*shell in center of next X-st, sc in next sc; rep from \* across, end 3 dc in last sc, changing to C on last st.

**Row 3:** With C, ch 1, sc in first dc, ch 1, X-st, ch 1, \*sc in center dc of next shell, ch 1, X-st, ch 1; rep from \* across, end sc in last dc, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*shell in center of next X-st, sc in next sc; rep from \* across, changing to A on last st, turn.

Rep Rows 1-4 working 2 rows of each color as established.



**Pattern #9**

SPECIAL STITCHES AND NOTE

**2-tr cluster (2 treble crochet cluster):** (Yarn over) 2 times, insert hook in indicated stitch or space and pull up a loop, (yarn over and pull through 2 loops on hook) 2 times; (yarn over) 2 times, insert hook in same stitch or space and pull up a loop, (yarn over and pull through 2 loops on hook) 2 times; yarn over and pull through all 3 loops on hook.

**Shell:** (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in one space.

**NOTE:** Do not cut yarns at end of rows, but carry yarns up side of work. Yarns will be waiting to be picked up and worked on the appropriate edge. To work with new color, pull up a loop of that color in the first stitch of the row and continue as directed.

Using Colors A, B and C.

With A, chain a multiple of 8 + 2.

**Set-Up Row (WS):** With A, sc in 2nd ch from hook, ch 1, sc in next ch, ch 4, skip 5 ch, sc in next ch, \*ch 2, skip 1 ch, sc in next ch, ch 4, skip 5 ch, sc in next ch; rep from \* to last ch, ch 1, sc in last ch, turn.

**Row 1 (RS):** With A, ch 1, sc in first sc, shell in next ch-4 space, \*sc in next ch-2 space, shell in next ch-4 space; rep from \* across, end sc in last sc, changing to B [see Note 3, page 1], turn.

**Row 2 (WS):** With B, ch 6 (counts as tr and ch-2), 2-tr cluster in same st, ch 2, skip 1 shell, \*(2-tr cluster, ch 4, 2-tr cluster) in next sc, ch 2, skip 1 shell; rep from \* across, end (2-tr cluster, ch 2, tr) in last sc, changing to C, turn.

**Row 3 (RS):** With C, ch 3 (counts as dc), 3 dc in ch-2 space, sc in ch-1 space of next shell 2 rows below, \*shell in next ch-4 space, sc in ch-1 space of next shell 2 rows below; rep from \* across, end 4 dc in last ch-2 space; **do not turn.**

**Row 4 (RS):** With B [see Note above], ch 1, sc in same st, ch 1, (2-tr cluster, ch 4, 2-tr cluster) in next sc, \*ch 2, (2-tr cluster, ch 4, 2-tr cluster) in next sc; rep from \* across, end ch 1, skip 3 dc, sc in last dc, changing to A, turn.


**Row 5 (WS):** With A, ch 1, sc in first sc, shell in next ch-4 space, sc in ch-1 of next shell 2 rows below; rep from \*, ending last rep sc in last sc; **do not turn.**

**Row 6 (WS):** With B, rep Row 2 but **do not turn at end of row.**

**Row 7 (WS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), 3 dc in ch-2 space, sc in ch-1 space of next shell 2 rows below, \*shell in next ch-4 space, sc in ch-1 space of next shell 2 rows below; rep from \* across, end 4 dc in tr, turn.

**Row 8 (RS):** Rep Row 4, but **do not turn at end of row.**

Repeat Rows 1-8 for pattern.



**Pattern #10**

SPECIAL STITCHES AND NOTE

**Long dc (long double crochet):** Dc in dc 3 rows below, working over the ch-3 and ch-1 spaces and pulling up first loop of dc to same level as current row.

**NOTE:** Do not cut yarns at end of rows, but carry yarns up side of work. Yarns will be waiting to be picked up and worked on the appropriate edge. To work with new color, pull up a loop of that color in the first stitch of the row and continue as directed.

Using Colors A, B and C and working 2 rows of each color beginning with Set-Up Row 2.

With A, chain a multiple of 4 + 2.

**Set-Up Row 1 (WS):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, \*ch 3, skip 3 ch, sc in next ch; rep from \* across, changing to B on last st [see Note 3, page 1], turn.

**Set-Up Row 2:** With B, ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), \*dc in next ch-3 space; skip 1 foundation ch, dc in next foundation ch working over ch-3, dc in same ch-3 space, ch 1; rep from \* across, end dc in last sc, turn.

**Row 1:** With same color, ch 1, sc in first dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc, sc in next dc, \*ch 3, skip (dc, ch 1, dc), sc in next dc; rep from \* to last 2 sts, ch 1, skip 1 dc, sc in last top of turning ch, changing to next color on last st, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1, \*dc in next ch-3 space, long dc, dc in same ch-3 space, ch 1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, dc in last ch-1 space, dc in last sc, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first dc, ch 3, skip (dc, ch 1, dc), sc in next dc; rep from \* across, changing to next color on last st, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, dc in next ch-3 space, long dc, dc in same ch-3 space, \*ch 1, dc in next ch-3 space, long dc, dc in same ch-3 space; rep from \* to last st, dc in last sc, turn.

Rep Rows 1-4, changing colors every 2 rows as established.
